

The following list of rules is to be read and followed. Any boarder who fails to comply with any of the rules on this list will be subject to immediate termination of privileges at the sole discretion of the management.

NO DOGS WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION!

NO GUNS!

NO OUTSIDE STALLIONS!

NO SMOKING

No yelling, running or loud music around the horses.

Parents are responsible for all minor children. Unattended children not allowed.

While discipline may be necessary, physical ABUSE of any horse WILL NOT be tolerated.

Any equipment used is to be put away when finished.

All gates shall be kept shut at all times, except while passing through.

Boarders are responsible for their quest(s). All quests are expected to follow all of the Stable Rules.

Guests vehicles & horses are by pre-arrangement only. Guests must have proof of negative Coggins test and sign a Fox Trot Farm release form. (This is not necessary if you meet off property to go riding together.)

No minors are to trade horses, unless their parents are present or with previous written permission provided to stable owners.

All grooming equipment shall be put away after use and not left laying around. Non-Fox Trot Farm equipment brought here must have been clearly marked with owner's name.

On the bulletin board is a space for notices (i.e. vet, farrier, etc.). It is up to all boarders to read notices which apply to their horse(s).

Absolutely no dumping anything on the premises, except in designated area.

Crosstie area shall be kept clean. Be considerate, if your horse(s) make a mess, clean it up.

Crossties should be occupied only as necessary.

Feed room shall be kept clean and neat.

Horse trailer parking is available. Tack may be stored in the trailer, but Fox Trot Farm shall not be liable for the security of the tack or trailer.

Regular deworming is required. You may choose to have your horses done at the same time as the other horses on the premises.

There shall be a Sign In/Out & Travel Plan form posted. When you leave to go riding, this must have been filled out. If your horse comes back without you, or you don't come back before dark, we want to know when/where to go look for you! (This is a nuisance but it is for your safety! In the event that the form has been blown away by Mother Nature - please leave a note on the bulletin board.)

Riders accept full responsibility for any risks taken while riding.

All riders must wear protective headgear. However, riding apparel & equipment repair are the responsibility of the rider.

We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.
